

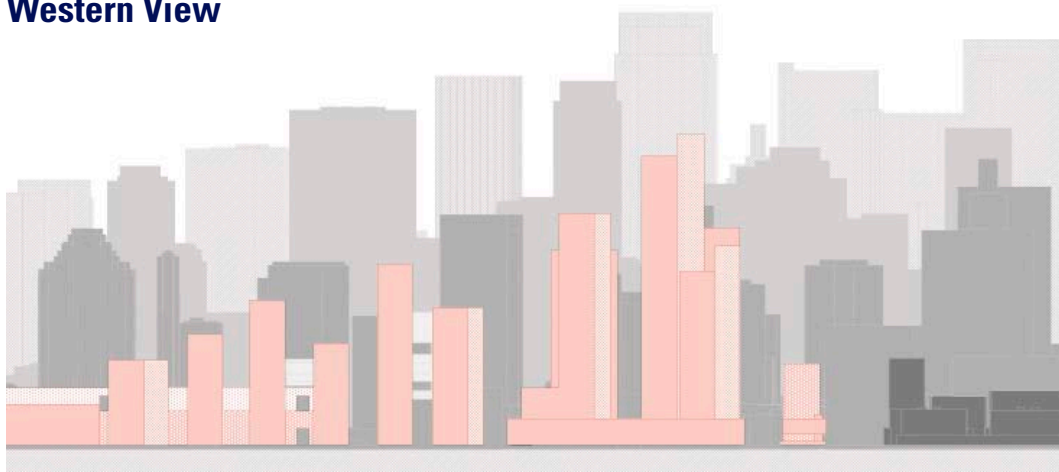
BARANGAROO ACTION GROUP

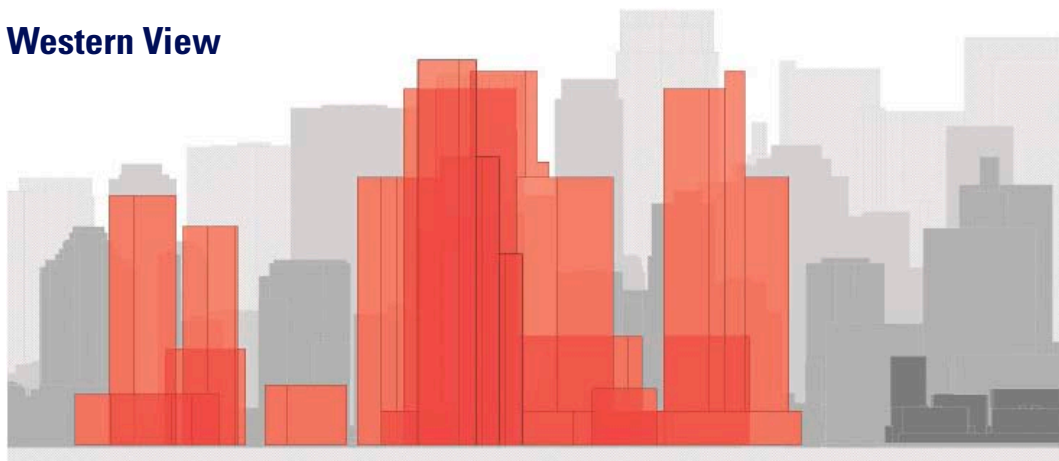

Our Aims

- **Buildings to be set well back from the foreshore leaving uncluttered public space to the water's edge**
- **No commercial buildings to be erected in the middle of harbour waters**
- **Total building area and height limits to remain as per the original award winning design**
- **Appoint an independent consent authority, acceptable to Sydney City Council and other community representatives, to determine building heights, floor space and infrastructure issues such as transport and parking**
- **Support a public enquiry into the role, obligations and decisions of the Barangaroo Delivery Authority, including its decision to award the proposed development to Lend Lease**
- **Allow multiple competing developers rather than a single developer for the whole site**
- **Change the rules for State significant developments to serve the interests of the NSW public rather than those of private developers and to prevent another Barangaroo**
